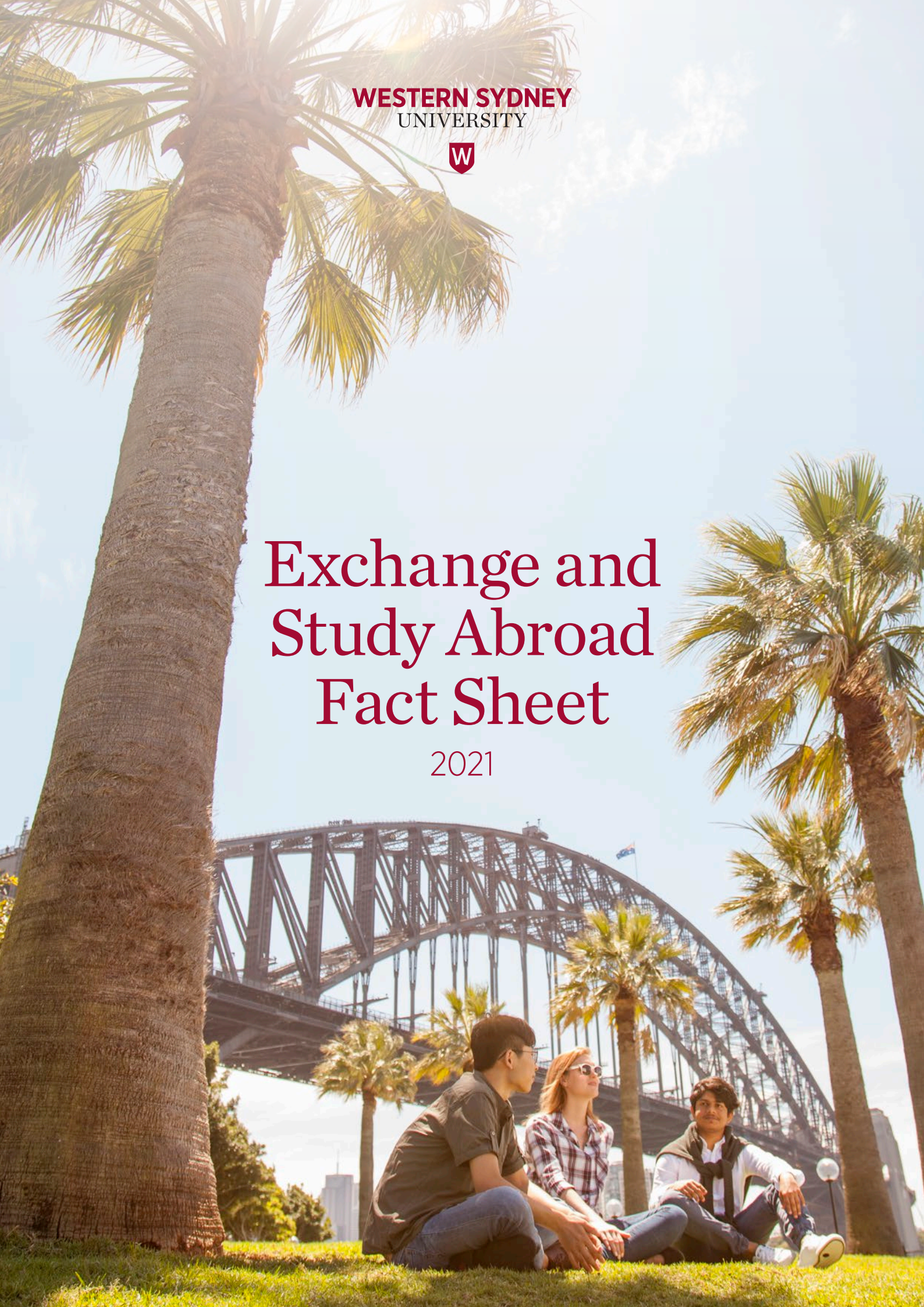

### SYDNEY GRADUATE SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT (SGSM)

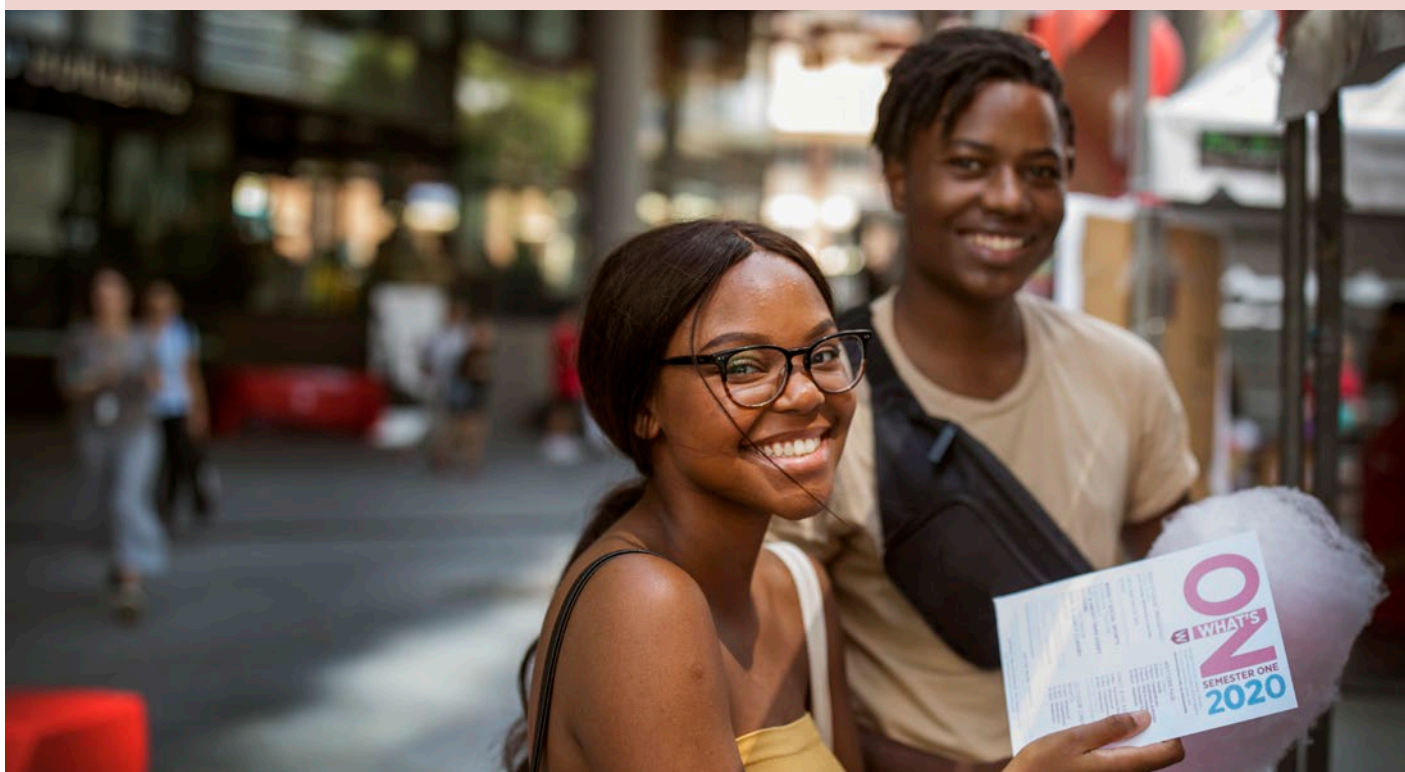
Only Postgraduate Business courses are available at SGSM. Students study two courses per Quarter (equivalent to a full study load) and combine two Quarters in order to complete the equivalent of a semester load.

**Quarter 1** Study Period: 11 January – 28 March 2021  
**Quarter 2** Study Period: 6 April – 20 June 2021  
**Quarter 3** Study Period: 28 June – 12 September 2021  
**Quarter 4** Study Period: 20 September – 5 December 2021

## EXCHANGE-RELATED INFORMATION

**DURATION OF EXCHANGE** 1 or 2 Sessions (excepting PG Business units) or 2 or 4 Quarters (only PG Business units)

**RESTRICTED UNITS** As a general rule, students can take most units, subject to availability and meeting the prerequisites.  
Units in the School of Medicine and School of Nursing and Midwifery are not available to exchange and study abroad students.

**MINIMUM/MAXIMUM NUMBER OF UNITS** 3 or 4 units per session  
1 or 2 units per Quarter (only PG Business)

**CROSS-SCHOOL UNITS** Yes, this is permitted.

**CROSS-CAMPUS UNITS** We do not permit cross-campus enrolment, due to the lengthy travel time between campus.

## ARRIVAL

**ARRIVAL DATES** It is recommended that students arrive three days prior to Orientation.

**AIRPORT RECEPTION** The University offers a free airport pick-up service to help students make their way from Sydney Airport (Kingsford Smith International Airport) to your Western Sydney University campus. Students must submit the request within five (5) working days of arrival to allow sufficient time to process the request.

## VISAS

Western Sydney University will issue successful applicants with an electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE) that they can use to lodge an application for the Student Visa (subclass 500).

Students cannot study with us on the Working Holiday Visa (subclass 417) or the Work and Holiday Visa (subclass 462).

## HEALTH INSURANCE

It is a visa requirement that almost all students purchase Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) insurance. Exceptions are:

- Belgian students covered under the Reciprocal Health Care Agreement with Australia
- Norwegian students covered by the Norwegian National Insurance Scheme
- Swedish students covered by Kammarkollegiet
