Course Load

Students can take up to 19 credits per semester. Normally, one course is awarded 2 or 3 credits.

Courses

You can choose any undergraduate course regardless of your major unless there is a prerequisite requirement.

Courses in English

Approximately 15% of all courses are taught in English. There are several programs in which a large majority of the classes are taught in English: Lifelong Education, Christian Studies, English Language and Literature, Business Management and Media.

Asian Studies Program

The Asian Studies Program has been developed specifically with international students in mind. It is designed for students who are interested in learning or increasing their knowledge of Asian culture and history. These courses are offered at no extra cost. All courses are taught in English and are offered both Spring and Fall semesters. Upon completing a minimum of six courses, students, who have obtained a GPA of 2.5, will be awarded a certificate.

Korean Language Course

We offer leveled Korean language classes in the evening at no extra cost. These classes provide students with an excellent opportunity to improve their Korean language skills and understand Korean culture. They will help students understand and use familiar expressions in everyday situations, which will help them make real life connections in Korea outside of the classroom.

Credit Transfer

Credits earned at Soongsil will be transferred to the home university according to their rules and regulations.

Application Process
Application Periods

- Spring Semester: October 1 - November 15
- Fall Semester: April 1 - May 15

Application Procedure

The application process consists of two phases. Therefore, it is important for nominated students to be attentive to their emails throughout the application process.

Phase I.

1. Complete the following required documents and email them to the Office of International Relations within the application periods.

Required Documents

- a. Nomination Form
 - b. Application Form (With a current photo attached)
 - c. Housing Application Form
 - d. Official Academic Transcript
 - e. Statement of Purpose
 - f. Copy of Identity page of Passport
 - g. Recent Color Photo
2. Once the application is received the student will receive confirmation of receipt via email.
 3. 3 to 4 weeks after the application deadline, students will receive an acceptance letter with an information pack.

Phase II.

4. Complete the following required documents and email them to the Office of International Relations by application deadline: Spring Semester-February 1, Fall Semester-August 1

Application Process

- Please send a dormitory application form along with the dormitory application fee of USD 30 (non-refundable).
- After reviewing housing applications, we will announce the housing assignment results in late February for the Spring semester and in late July for the Fall semester. Please note that you might not be assigned to the housing of choice based on availability. However, every attempt will be made to meet the student's request.

Payment Procedure

You will need to pay a housing fee within the first week of the semester by wire transfer. We will inform students of the banking information and payment deadline the last week of February for Spring semester and August for Fall semester.

Visa (D-2-4)

Every student will need to obtain a student visa before coming to Korea. In order to obtain the visa, students need to apply for it at the Korean consulate near their own home. Please consult with the consulate as to the required documents. The following is a general list required documents for issuing a student visa.

Required Documents

- Application Form (www.hikorea.go.kr)
- Passport
- Certificate of Admission (This will be issued by Soongsil University.)
- Proof of Financial Support (A bank statement or a scholarship certificate proving that you maintain a minimum balance or have a scholarship certificate to receive a visa)
- Two color photos (3.5 cm x 4.5 cm)
- Visa processing fee
- Other documents required by the Korean consulate

Health Insurance

Health insurance is mandatory for all exchange students. You are required to have health insurance which covers the entire length of your stay in Korea. If you purchase health insurance through the International Office, it will cost approximately 140,000 KRW for 6 months and 200,000 KRW for 12 months.

Medical Certificate

It is important for students to make sure that all immunizations are up to date. Please submit the medical certificate completed by a physician.

Course Registration

We will send accepted students a course list at the beginning of February for the Spring semester and the beginning of August for the Fall semester. In principle, students are allowed to take any course offered at Soongsil regardless of their major. The students should send a list of courses chosen by a designated date to the following e-mail address: siso@soongsil.ac.kr Further instructions will be emailed directly to students.

Arrival and Departure Date

We encourage students to book their flight according to housing check-in and check-out dates. Students on D-2-4 visa are asked to leave for their home countries within 30 days after a semester ends. If they do not abide by the rule, the Korean Immigration Office may regard them as an illegal alien.

Airport Pick-up Service

Airport pick-up service is available on designated dates, normally a few days before a semester starts. Students who cannot arrive on the designated dates will need to get to Soongsil University on their own.
