Internship curriculum of the Faculty of Architecture and Civil Engineering for the practical semester of the Bachelor degree course ARCHITECTURE

Practical semester

Takes place: 6th semester

Duration: 20 weeks (including a two-week teaching block)

Internship

Training objective:

You will be introduced to the practical work of the architectural profession by familiarising yourself with the tasks of planning, construction management, construction preparation and execution. You will gain an understanding of the demands of the practical environment and impact on planning and construction preparation.

Training content:

1. Planning: You will gain an insight into the work and interaction of planners, builders, authorities and specialists. You will be involved in the basic evaluation, draft and permission planning, quantity surveying and cost estimation.
2. Construction preparation: You will be involved in production planning and detailed planning, quantity and cost calculation and tendering.
3. Building operations: You will be involved in construction management in the areas of approval, error establishment, error eradication, cost control, measurement, invoicing and documentation.

Internship locations:

Architecture and engineering firms with involvement in building construction, building authorities, companies with their own planning departments and construction management.
