If the report contains confidential data, please note this clearly. Please also read the guidelines for practical semesters of the Internship Office .

### **Confidentiality of reports**

The report will only be read by the internship supervisor. In order to be able to evaluate your activities, your description must contain all the essential information. If this includes confidential, internal company data, you should emphasise this again at the beginning of the report. If necessary, it is also possible that the practice supervisor concludes a confidentiality agreement with your company.
