Founded in 1936, Vancouver Island University (VIU) is a public university with currently about 12,000 students and more than 120 study programs in various fields. Small class sizes of 34 students maximum provide the ideal learning environment and a dynamic dialogue between students and professors. The main VIU campus is located in the harbor city of Nanaimo on Vancouver Island. This spectacular location allows for various outdoor activities and sports all year round due to the close proximity to the mountains, the forest and the ocean. Big city life in Vancouver is only a ferry ride away and the tourist attraction Victoria is reachable within a short car or bus ride.

Academic Year

The academic year at VIU is divided into semesters, each running for four months. There are two start dates each year: January and September

• Spring: beginning of January to end of April • Fall: end of August to mid-December

Exam Period	During the last two weeks of each semester.		
Orientation Period	A mandatory orientation period takes place prior to course start.		
Application	To apply to VIU, please submit the following documents via email to our European office: Application form Official academic transcripts in English Master students also need to hand in their Bachelor diploma in English Proof of English proficiency (waived for students from German partner institutions): TOEFL: 88 (Bachelor) and 93 (Master) with no band below 20 respectively IELTS: 6.5 with no band below 6.0 (Bachelor) and 7.0 with no band below 6.5 (Master) Cambridge Certificate: 176 (Bachelor) and 185 (Master)		
Application Deadline	The application deadline for Bachelor's degree programs starting in September 2025 is April 30th, 2025 and for Master's degree programs March 31st, 2025. For the spring intake in January 2026, you must apply by October 31st, 2025 for Bachelor's degree programs and by July 31st, 2025 for Master's degree programs. After these deadlines, applications are usually still possible after consultation. Please also note the internal deadlines of your home university.		
Visa This information is supplied without liability	Many students who study in Canada for less than six months do not require a Study Permit. Please note that visa-exempt foreign nationals who fly to or transit through Canada will need an Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA).
