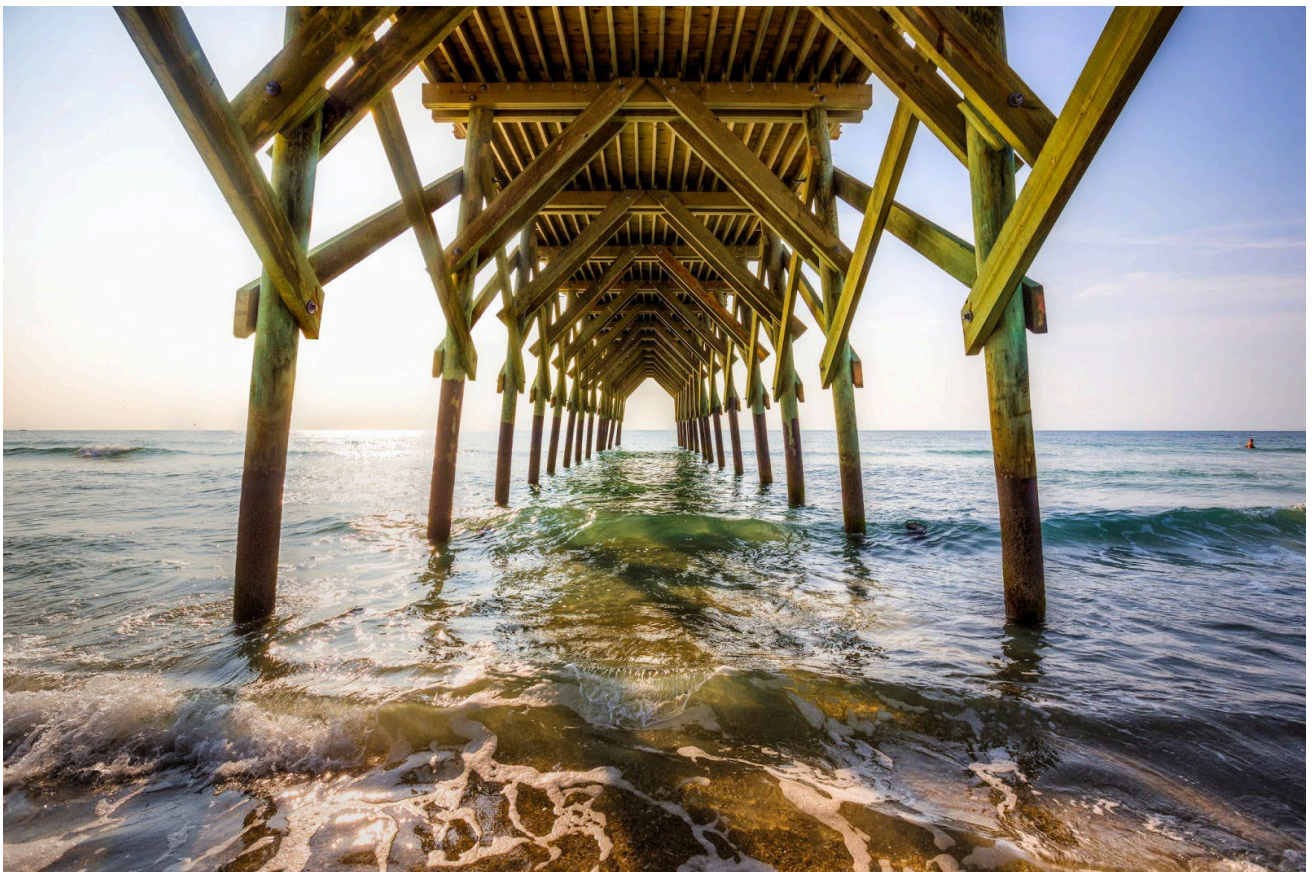

Obtaining U.S. student visa	<p>Once admitted, students will be mailed an acceptance letter along with J1 exchange student immigration document DS-2019. Using the two documents, students will need to complete the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pay the <a href="#">I-901 SEVIS Fee</a></li> <li>• Locate your nearest <a href="#">U.S. Embassy</a></li> <li>• Follow the embassy's website instructions for obtaining a Non-Immigrant J1 Exchange Student Visa</li> <li>• Estimate the wait time by selecting your Embassy location on the <a href="#">U.S. Visa Wait Times website</a></li> </ul>
Accommodation	<p><b>On-Campus</b></p> <p>Students are guaranteed on-campus housing after they are admitted to UNCW and if they apply by the deadline. Students are emailed instructions upon admission.</p> <p>Visiting Internationals have options of <a href="#">University Suites or the Seahawk complexes</a>.</p> <p><b>Off-Campus</b></p> <p>Students are permitted to live off-campus, but UNCW does not place students in off-campus apartments. They may use the <a href="#">UNCW Off-Campus Housing Service</a> for help.</p>
Airport Shuttle provided	We happily offer a full day of airport shuttle once on-campus housing opens. Once admitted, students will receive the dates/times for the airport shuttle.
Airport location	The local airport is ILM, we will only provide airport shuttle from the ILM airport.
