ACCOMODATION

The most popular way to share your experience in Spain is to live in a university residence or to rent an apartment with other students. Sharing your life with Spanish students is also a great way to learn more about local customs, improve your Spanish language, and delve into its culture. University residence:

There is a University residence CMU Ramón Acín which provides accommodation for the full academic year. It has capacity for 125 students (51 double rooms, 23 single rooms).

Apartments and rooms to let

The cost of renting an apartment ranges from 150 € to 350€ per person per month, depending on the area and type of apartment. In most cases, it is necessary to leave a deposit equal to one month's rent, paid in advance.
